<div>Description</div> <div>Much like the selection of a category can link a default assignee I would like to see this extended to allow for the setting of other fields to possible default values.</div> <div>e.g. I have a tester field of type user. When a new issue of a certain category is created I can currently have it assigned to Bob then I would also like to have the tester field for that item set to Jane as well at creation time.</div> <div>So in the edit category area there would be an add new association link that would allow me to select a field and then a value from the field.</div> <div>This would support more than just one extra association.</div> <div>Having this ability for other fields than just categories would be really cool. e.g. if an issue gets assigned to Bob then allow me conditionally set another field(s) to a value.</div>
