**Description**

This is really a minor issue. However, everytime I explain how to use Redmine people ask the same question:

*What is the difference between duplicate and copy?*

And I always offer the same answer:

- "Duplicate" is for cloning the issue and leaving it in the same project.
- "Copy" is for copying the issue somewhere else

However, from time to time they come back and ask again. I suspect :-)) the captions are not selfexplanatory

My proposal is to remove the caption "copy" and use **"copy to"** instead
