<p>In both the overview of a repository and in the details of a specific commit "ascii-style" lists are shown in a strange manner. Note in the attached images that item no. 2 onwards have an extra space of padding on the left. Additionally, the whole list (<i>including</i> the first item) get a monospaced font.</p> <p>Server: Ubuntu 12.04 server Git: 1.7.9.5</p> <p>The output of 'git log' in the actual repo on the server is:</p> <pre>Improved daemon functionality New features to the daemon: - It will check if it is already running via a lockfile - It handles SIGTERM: writes to the log and deletes the lockfile - blah blah blah - The usage() text reflects the changes</pre> <p>with one space before and after the dashes. The missing linebreak (subjective) is covered in Issue #10968. Also related is Issue #10886.</p> <p>It seems the space before the first item in the list starts "monospace mode" and is therefore stripped.</p>
