<p>I'm somewhat new to redmine, I tried to figure out how to configure user privilege about "creating a project", but failed to find one on user configuration page.</p> <p>It was actually on the user-project privilege configuration page.</p> <p>If I'm correct, current process of assigning users the privilege about creating a project is:</p> <p>a. Create a privilege in roles and permissions page (if it doesn't exist yet, optional)</p> <p>Check "Create project"</p> <p>b. Select a user and assign a project with the privilege from (a)</p> <p>c. End, now that user can create a project.</p>			
<p>But I think it's more natural assigning a privilege like "create project" should go into the user configuration page.</p> <p>It's not related to some projects, isn't it?</p> <p>(maybe it's fixed already in the current version. Im using 1.2.1, because im so lazy --)</p>
