<p>This may or may not be a bug depending on the precise specification, but I suppose it should work... When using Redmine links, I can either</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- link to a file in a non-primary repository using <code>source:myrepository /path/to/file</code>or- link to a file with spaces using <code>source:"path/with spaces/to file.txt"</code> <p>It would appear logical that these two could be combined to form a link to a file with spaces in a non-primary repository using <code>source:myrepository "path/with spaces/to file.txt"</code>, but that is not recognized as a Redmine link (or at least, recognized only up to the <code> </code> character). I suspect that the problem is with the giant regexp in <code>parse_redmine_links</code> in <code>`application_helper.rb`</code>, but it is a little too intimidating for me to wade in there and attempt a fix myself.</p>
