<p>In our team, 98% of closed issues have progress set to 100%. Currently, when closing a ticket, this means changing status and progress manually every time. My proposal: Per default set progress to 100% when status is switched to closed. This should happen in frontend code, so that when somebody wants to set progress to something else then 100% while closing the issue, that's still possible.</p> <p>I've seen <a href="http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineSettings#Calculate-the-issue-done-ratio">http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineSettings#Calculate-the-issue-done-ratio</a> where this can be configured, but that completely removes the option to set progress manually.</p>
