<p>If you log in and then revisit the /login page, Redmine currently logs you out and requires you to log back in. I believe this is unexpected behavior, as if you do this on most websites, you're redirected as though you just logged in.</p> <p>The patch attached fixes this issue explained.</p> <p>Redmine 2.1.4.stable Ruby 1.9.3 Rails 3.2.8</p> <p>This issue is similar to #11847 ;however, has nothing to do with back_url and is solving the bigger problem, I think.</p>
