<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Unknown project IDs don't trigger error messages. Example: "5", where no project with ID 5 exists</li><li>• Invalid integer does not trigger error message. Example: "gg"</li><li>• Accepts value "1a" and parses it to 1</li><li>• Empty values (for example, "&lt;tracker_id&gt;&lt;/tracker_id&gt;" do not trigger error message)</li></ul>
