This also prevents RedMine from gathering any changesets after this issue. For example, this was accidentally committed by one of our developers the other day.</p> <pre>"Fixes #340 Fixes #340 rest of message here about the changes..."</pre> <p>While not verified, a possible fix would be to add "self.issues.uniq!" at the end of "ChangeSet.scan_comment_for_issue_ids".</p> <p>Cheers, Nick</p>
