<p>Hello,</p> <p>We use Git repository.</p> <p>When someone in the team forgets to mention "IssueID #xxx" in the commit text (or for any other reason), <u>we manually add the link between the commit and the issue</u> directly from Redmine, opening the "commit" page, and clicking "Add" in the "Related Issues" section.</p> <p>Now, I am trying to migrate the git repository from a path to another, but since <u>changing the URL is not possible</u>, I followed the suggestions found around to change the repository URL: <u>delete, then add the repository</u> (with the same repository name).</p> <p>So, I tried "delete" and then "add" (with the same repository name and a different path), but in this way <u>I'm losing all the links</u> between the commits and the issues that were made clicking "Add" in the commit's page in Redmine.</p>
