<p>When used with automatic repository creation mode, it would be a nice feature to have the repository generated using svnsync from a URL and credentials, this would allow people to migrate projects from other systems into redmine system complete with history. This would require the following steps</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Create the repository as normal2. Change the pre-revprop-change hook to allow only one user to write (see svnsync docs)3. Run svnsync with destination repository, credentials and URL.4. When completed, remove pre-revprop-change hook <p>Hook files and auth files are not migrated with svnsync so the repository would then work correctly with the perl svn auth library.</p>
