<p>Links generated by the wiki are invalid when they contain something that could be an email. For example, this :</p> <p>http://foo@www.bar.com</p> <p>is transformed to</p> <pre>&lt;a class=\"external\" href=\"http://&lt;a href=\"mailto:www.foo@bar.com\" class=\"email\"&gt;www.foo@bar.com&lt;/a&gt;\"&gt;http://&lt;a href=\"mailto:www.foo@bar.com\" class=\"email\"&gt;www.foo@bar.com&lt;/a&gt;&lt;/a&gt;</pre> <p>and rendered as this <a href="http://foo@www.bar.com">http://foo@www.bar.com</a> in a web browser.</p> <p>I observed this problem by using hg fetch that generates commit messages like :</p> <p>Automated merge with https://login@hg.foo.com/project.</p> <p>Here is a patch that solves the problem and a unit test. The code come from <a href="http://dev.rubyonrails.org/changeset/7516">http://dev.rubyonrails.org/changeset/7516</a>. The only limitation of this solution is in that case :</p> <p>http://foo@bar.com foo@bar.com</p> <p>where only the first link is detected. I did not found the magic regexp. Maybe this could be solved with some lookbehind but the syntax is not supported on ruby 1.8.</p>
