## **Description**

Links generated by the wiki are invalid when they contain something that could be an email. For example, this:

http://foo@www.bar.com

is transformed to

\$\$ <a class="email'"> href="http://<a href="mailto:www.foo@bar.com" class="email'"> www.foo@bar.com</a> "> http://<a href="mailto:www.foo@bar.com" class="email"> www.foo@bar.com" class="email"> www.foo@bar.com"> http://<a href="emailto:www.foo@bar.com" class="email"> www.foo@bar.com"> http://<a href="emailto:www.foo@bar.com" class="emailto:www.foo@bar.com"> http://<a href="emailto:www.foo@bar.com"> http

and rendered as this <a href="http://foo@www.bar.com">http://foo@www.bar.com</a> in a web browser.

I observed this problem by using hg fetch that generates commit messages like:

Automated merge with https://login@hg.foo.com/project.

Here is a patch that solves the problem and a unit test. The code come from <a href="http://dev.rubyonrails.org/changeset/7516">http://dev.rubyonrails.org/changeset/7516</a>. The only limitation of this solution is in that case :

http://foo@bar.com foo@bar.com

where only the first link is detected. I did not found the magic regexp. Maybe this could be solved with some lookbehind but the syntax is not supported on ruby 1.8.
