## **Description**

While trying to add some custom filters I found out that even if you call sql\_for\_field with specific table and field name, it still uses #{queries\_table\_name}.status\_id as field in generated WHERE statement. You can see the problem in /app/models/query.rb:687

I'd like to change it to #{db\_table}.#{db\_field} (this seems more extendable and corresponds with what is written in another operators' code).

Forget to mention: usage of #{queries\_table\_name} also looks very strange, all other operators use #{db\_table} instead. That was the main problem for me - I had to select all TimeEntry which are related to closed issues, and #{queries\_table\_name} was TimeEntries instead of Issues.
