<p>While trying to add some custom filters I found out that even if you call <code>sql_for_field</code> with specific table and field name, it still uses <code>#{queries_table_name}.status_id</code> as field in generated WHERE statement. You can see the problem in <code>/app/models/query.rb:687</code></p> <p>I'd like to change it to <code>#{db_table}.#{db_field}</code> (this seems more extendable and corresponds with what is written in another operators' code).</p>

Forget to mention: usage of `#{queries_table_name}` also looks very strange, all other operators use `#{db_table}` instead. That was the main problem for me - I had to select all TimeEntry which are related to closed issues, and `#{queries_table_name}` was TimeEntries instead of Issues.
