Description			
<p>In an attempt to integrate redmine more tightly with my own applications, I'm trying to create users through the API.</p> <p>I managed to get authenticated and get a list of current users, but on posting to /Users.xml, I get a 500.</p> <p>I posted the example xml from here: http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/Rest_Users#POST.</p> <p>This might be a bug, but since I'm getting this on my current install, which is 2.0.1, as well as a fresh install in the bitnami cloud, which is 2.3.3, it's also possible I'm just doing something stupid.</p> <p>I attached the request and the response.</p> <p>Also, here's the version info from the two installations I tested with the same result:</p> <p>Bitnami cloud machine:</p> <p>Environment: Redmine version 2.3.3.stable Ruby version 1.9.3-p448 (2013-06-27) [x86_64-linux] Rails version 3.2.13 Environment production Database adapter Mysql2 Redmine plugins: no plugin installed</p> <p>My production system:</p> <p>Environment: Redmine version 2.0.1.stable Ruby version 1.9.3 (i386-mingw32) Rails version 3.2.3 Environment production Database adapter SQLite Redmine plugins: no plugin installed</p>
