<p>I'd expect the date filters in the <code>[[Rest_Issues#Listing-issues issue REST API]]</code> to work with date time values as well as with dates. I wanted to filter for issues updated after a specific time. Using the date time filter</p> <p>unencoded: <code>updated_on=>=2013-12-29T17:17:33</code> URL-encoded: <code>updated_on=%3e%3d2013-12-29%2017%3a17%3a33</code></p> <p>in the ISO 8601 format yields the same internal server error as using the date time format used for the <code>updated_on</code> node returned by another successful query:</p> <pre><updated_on>Sun Jan 03 12:08:41 +0100 2010</updated_on></pre> <p>Related issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- #8842- #10402
