<p>We've started using Due Date as a way of determining priority and scheduling work within the team.</p> <p>While Priority and Due Date work independently though, the onus is on the team to constantly update the priority as the due date approaches.</p> <p>It would be good to be able to automate priority increases though I'm aware these formulas would need to be tied to each value in the enum.</p> <p>Calculation capabilities based on est effort / time spent / % Done might also be useful.</p>
