<p><b>Description</b></p> <p>I've recently updated to 2.4.3 and when I try to upload a file I get this response from the server:</p> <p>Request Entity Too Large</p> <p>The file is 1.3 MB so I reckon this won't be a problem (and it hasn't been before). Redmine is served through Apache and Passenger.
