<b>Description</b> Currently, one can set a default person for the category. It should be possible to set a default person for uncategorized problems, in this very same UI.  Currently I am using plugin "Default assignee" but since its not native it interferes with category defaults. By adding default assignee for uncategorized issues, there is much more consistency in this feature.
