**Description**

Hi there!

Normally, when using

```
"Link to projects":/projects
```

results in:  
[Link to projects](http://www.redmineserver.org/projects) (www.redmineserver.org/projects)

However, if redmine-website is located under say  
**www.redmineserver.org/redm/**

then

```
"Link to projects":/projects
```

**will incorrectly link to**  
www.redmineserver.org/projects

It **should actually** link to  
www.redmineserver.org/redm/projects

The problem is there, even if I have set  
*Administration->Settings->General*

- Host name and path: redmineserver.org/redm

**Suggestion:**  
Perhaps a new syntax is needed...

```
"link":/projects # links to <Host name and path>/projects  
"link"::/otherpage # links to <Host name>/otherpage  
# <Host name and path>  
# as set under:  
# Administration->Settings->General
```
