<b>Description</b>			
Currently, when creating a project, the user has to uncheck modules he does not want to use (all modules being active by default).  One should be able to define a set of modules he wants active by default, so you could go a little faster when creating a project.  The admin would choose the default set of modules using the settings controller, in a new tab or using the general tab. Maybe a "projects" tab could be used for displaying projects defaults (at the moment the only configurable default is "public availability", Modules if this feature is implemented, and we could imagine adding Trackers and Custom Fields).
