<p>When upgrading to Redmine 3.0.0 we found out that the table with the required Ruby versions (<a href="http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineInstall#Ruby-interpretor">http://www.redmine.org/projects/redmine/wiki/RedmineInstall#Ruby-interpretor</a>) is outdated. In my opinion all released versions should be covered by the table. Like mentioned in the news (<a href="http://www.redmine.org/news/95">http://www.redmine.org/news/95</a>) Redmine 3.0.0 requires ruby 1.9.3. It looks like the row "current trunk" already contains the correct data for Redmine 3.0.0. Or maybe i just interpreted the table wrong?</p>
