<b>Description</b> <p>Redmine has all information to draw activity graphs for a project. It would be the same as current "/projects/activity/&lt;name&gt;" but using a graph. The X axis would represent time. Ideally there could be</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• one line/graph for each kind of activity (tickets, wiki, news...) the use could select what is displayed</li><li>• a 'total' graph summarizing it all</li></ul> <p>And, in a perfect world, it would even be possible to compare activity of different projects on the same graph :)</p>
