<p>People now use a lot of Web apps (cms, web mail). Those often share the same hosting and HTTP authentication can be a simple way to get a single sign on feature (especially on the LAN, inside a company).</p> <p>What I understand is that this requires (for a kinda quick & dirty support) :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- create a new AuthSource type (let's say AuthSourceHTTP)- add a new flag column to AuthSources table to test if Auth method rely on a form or not- if not manage things as a :before_filter in the login action. <p>I'll try to have a look on that and submit a sample patch, but I'm not a Ruby/Rails expert at all.</p>
