After the confirmation dialog I'm beeing redirected to http://www.redmine.org/plugins/redmine_emojibutton/versions/2011 and get a 403 error "not allowed to access this page".</p> <p>Plugin authors should be able to delete versions of their plugins in order to be able to do a roll back to a previous version.</p>
