<b>Description</b>			
<p>When clicking the new Import link in the side bar menu of Issues, the project information seems to be lost.</p> <p>There are several consequences:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Clicking the sidebar links in one of the import steps has various consequences, from no action (custom queries) to Error 500 (Calendar, Gantt)</li><li>2. When reaching the field mapping step, there is a project which is preselected, but not the one the import link was clicked from.</li></ol>
