And you catch this error here #21453 and fixed by adding force_encoding (maybe there was need to stop and check net-ldap). net-ldap 0.13 fixed for this, but dropped support ruby 1.9.3 (RM 3.2 still support).</p> <p>So, just info for others devs, which need to make any LDAP connections and read data.
