How to reproduce:			
1. Create a query: name = "order_by_id_asc", sort 1 = "#, ascending"			
2. Click the query name "order_by_id_asc" in the side bar of issues list screen. Issues are listed in <b>ascending</b> order of id.			
3. Click a "CSV" link on the bottom of the screen			
4. Open the CSV file. Ascending order of id is expected, but issues are listed in <b>descending</b> order of id.
