<b>Description</b>			
<p>The new code highlighting toolbar button (<a href="#">#14937</a> / <a href="#">r15316</a>) is providing support for all the CodeRay-supported languages except the 'taskpaper' language. While the CodeRay support for it can be questioned, I think it's best to keep the languages provided by the button in sync with the languages supported natively by CodeRay (as is the Redmine core documentation after <a href="#">r14489</a>).</p> <p>This issue is limited to simply adding the language name 'taskpaper' to the codeRayLanguages array in <a href="#">source:trunk/public/javascripts/jstoolbar/jstoolbar.js</a> (I'm ignoring the minification steps here).</p> <p>Thanks in advance.</p>
