<p>It's basically the same as solved here: <a href="#">#23172</a> - but now it's not about assignee but about watchers. In 3.3.1 assignee list is fixed, so now can be issues assigned only to users available in selected tracker. The same should be fixed for watchers. Now we can add watchers which are not available in specific tracker - the list of possible watchers should be limited only to users available in selected tracker.</p>
