Login back_url changes https to http

Description

When opening an URL with <https://...>, and the user needs to log in first, the url is changed to <http://>, even if the protocol is set to https. This happens directly within the login URL ('login?back_url=http://..').

Tested with 0.8.0 and the new 0.8.1.

Anyway it would be nice if redmine could always redirect to the specified protocol, so that people using http and https is set are automatically redirected to the https-address.
