I'm afraid the fix proposed in [#2879](#) doesn't work for Outlook/Exchange. My apologies for not doing enough research! Ticket [5288](#) in the trac project, and the end of [this post](#) on the MS Exchange Team blog suggest that adding:

```
Precedence: bulk
```

...to outbound emails will do the trick.
