<p>If you choose some issue filtering options, and save them for one project (by not clicking for all projects) it works.</p> <p>But if you edit it, and check All projects, it also works and is visible in all projects.</p> <p>However, if you uncheck All projects after that, it cannot be done, All projects checkbox stays on.</p> <p>The only workaround is to delete custom query, and create new one...</p>
