I think the button would be more useful and user-friendly if the button has an ability to attach a file.</p> <p>The following is my idea of the new behavior.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">You will see a file dialog if you click the "Image" button. You can open an image to embed with the dialog step-1-open-a-file-with-dialog.pngAfter opening an image with the dialog, the selected image file is attached and inserted to the textarea with markups step-2-file-is-embedded.png
