No problem in production mode.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Run Redmine in development mode (bin/rails s)2. Login with any user3. Go to "My account" and click "Enable authenticator app"4. Setup up two-factor authentication for the account5. Update some source file of Redmine (e.g. run touch config/locales/en.yml)6. 2. Go to "My account" and click "Generate backup codes"7.
