The upcoming Redmine 4.2 has a two-factor authentication feature ( <a href="#">#1237</a> ). I suggest adding twofa_scheme column to users CSV. From the perspective of information security management of an organization, the feature to obtain two-factor authentication status for all users is useful.
