# Description

Some `assert select` in the tests have wrong argument format. For example, the code at source:trunk/test/functional/timelog report test.rb@22254#L113 should be fixed as follows.

current wrong code:

assert\_select 'td.name a.user.active[href=?]', '/users/1', 1, :text => 'Redmine Admin'

fixed code:

```
assert_select 'td.name a.user.active[href=?]', '/users/1', :text => 'Redmine Admin', :count => 1
```

The current code probably be intended to check if there is one matching td.name a.user.active[href=/users/1] with text "Redmine Admin", but assert\_select recognizes the last argument :text => 'Redmine Admin' as a assertion message. As a result, the link text never been checked.

In Rails::Dom::Testing version 2.1.0 and later checks this kind of mistakes and raises ArgumentError. Raise an error if the last arg is the wrong format by ghiculescu · Pull Request #96 · rails/rails-dom-testing · GitHub
