As an example, with correct DNS and webserver configurations, I'd like to set :</p> <p><a href="http://www.project1.com">www.project1.com</a> --&gt; my.redmine.server/projects/project1</p> <p>or</p> <p>project1.my.redmine.server --&gt; my.redmine.server/projects/project1</p> <p>That way, we could host multiple projects with their own domain names on the same redmine server.</p>
