As of rev 684, there's a cross-project issue list (that lists issues for all visible projects).  
You can access it through 'My page' assigned/reported issues blocks.

There is an atom feed associated with this cross-project issue list (since rev 686). So you can define your own filter on the screen and use it as a feed.

Note that you'll find two pre-defined feeds on 'My page': 'Issues assigned to me' and 'Issues reported by me'.
