<p>The usage of ActiveSupport::Deprecation.warn has been deprecated in Rails 7.1 and has been removed in Rails 7.2. The attached patch fixes the deprecated usage by replacing ActiveSupport::Deprecation with a custom deprecation object.</p> <p>In Rails 7.1.2, calling ActiveSupport::Deprecation.warn produces the following deprecation warning:</p> <pre>\$ bin/rails r 'ActiveSupport::Deprecation.warn("warning!")'
