<b>Description</b>			
<p>Repository tests can fail if the required SCM client command is unavailable or outdated (e.g., Mercurial 5.1 or higher is required for the current trunk), resulting in a large number of test failures.</p> <p>To reproduce the issue, add the following lines to config/configuration.yml and run the repository tests.</p> <pre>scm_subversion_command: /tmp/invalid-svn scm_mercurial_command: /tmp/invalid-hg scm_git_command: /tmp/invalid-git scm_cvs_command: /tmp/invalid-cvs scm_bazaar_command: /tmp/invalid-bzr</pre> <p>The attached patch modifies the test setup so that repository tests are skipped when the corresponding SCM client command is not available. This avoids test failures in such environments.</p> <p>This issue is related to <a href="#">#33784#note-24</a>.</p>
