On one of my projects, I have 2630 members

When a user add a fliter based on Assigned\_to\_id in a custom report, it takes between 30 and 60 seconds to load the field. It happens on Firefox and it is a little more fast on IE but still too slow.

Is it related to my redmine version or the root cause can be eslewhere?

I check on database, everything is good, no overlay.

It seems the navigator has difficulties to absorp the amount of data.

It was not the same on version 3.3 we had before.
