<b>Description</b> I would like to be able to retrieve the subject for a given bug ID via a HTTP request.  e.g. if I entered into my browser: <a href="http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/*description*/130">http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/*description*/130</a>  I would receive just the subject text (with no html formatting) for issue 130.  An alternative might be <a href="http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?description">http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?description</a>  Which would then allow the following as well: <a href="http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?status">http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?status</a> <a href="http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?priority">http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?priority</a> <a href="http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?assigned_to">http://redmineserver:8181/redmine/issues/130?assigned_to</a>  Having this feature will allow me to show the issues description within other systems, leading to a more joined up system and increasing my groups productivity.
