<p>When viewing an issue all updates are shown. But when someone logs time with a comment this isn't shown in the history. So now we fill in the comment in the update and the time log but a lot of people forget that. I would really love to have the time log entries display within the history, just like a regular update.</p> <p>There have been a couple of tickets to display it in the activity displays: <a href="#">#3785</a>, <a href="#">#3809</a></p> <p>But I'd like it in the regular issue history as well.</p>
