Description			
I have a rendering issue in Google Chrome, which doesn't seem to appear in IE. Attached is a screenshot from Chrome.			
In our case, the field that is not wrapping correctly is a long text custom field. In IE this works correctly, but in Chrome, everything is on one line.

I manually applied the above patch which fixed this. But this may be still an issue on an unpatched version (.94).

Well, we already had several other bad rendering reports from users with non-stable versions of chrome, that's why I'm asking. Do you have a stable chrome version and could try it out on your redmine? The easiest way would be to comment out the CSS line added by the patch (you'll have to enclose it in `/* your comment here */`, # isn't a comment marker in CSS), empty your browser cache after that and see if the problem still is there.
