<p>First, thank you for such an awesome project management application!</p> <p>This may be considered more of an FYI.</p> <p>Feature Request: See if a different extension would resolve the issue of Firefox failing to download the gz.tar.md5 files on RubyForge or provide a notice to users about the issue on RubyForge.</p> <p>Issue: Firefox can't download the tar.gz.md5 files from RubyForge. I'm not sure why, but it complains with the following:</p> <pre>-snip-/redmine-0.9.3.tar.gz.md5 could not be saved, because the source file could not be read. Try again later, or contact the server administrator.</pre> <p>wget and MSIE download the files fine.</p> <p>The downloads were attempted with Firefox 3.5.9 for Ubuntu and Firefox 3.6.3 on Windows XP.</p> <p>Hope that helps.</p>
