Though issue list has lastupdate record, but does not have the name of last update user.</p> <p>First I tried to handle our staff's request, like this.</p> <pre># find laslatest journal by issue id def lastupdate_user(id)   lastJournal = Journal.find(:last, :conditions =&gt;     ["journalized_id= ?", id], :order =&gt; :created_on,     :include =&gt; :user)   if lastJournal != nil     return lastJournal.user   end end</pre> <p>But above is quite poor, and I'm afraid that this may cause some performance issues.</p> <p>If allowed, please add the column to issue table, and set the latest log (journal) id of the issue itself when updating.</p>
