I read about the XSS concerns.</p> <p>It should be possible to make this a configurable option in the administrative settings for the site. There are multiple methods that may work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Checkbox "turn on Textile style attributes, I am aware it can open my site to XSS vulnerabilities", which is check off by default.</li><li>• Pulldown "turn on Textile style attributes" with a selection for the various user "levels", i.e. manager only. Again put the XSS warning below.</li></ul> <p>This would really help us better format our public Wiki documents. If Textile styles are not possible, maybe a way to perform div-style blocks with positional parameters? Such as only allowing the padding and margin qualifiers on various attributes ( and */&lt;ul&gt; for example).</p> <p>Thoughts?</p>
