<p>Looking at the current calendar view in Redmine it is visible that issues are translated to English as being tasks in the calendar-legend. This can be confusing now that we also have subtasks (instead of subissues). This affects not only the English language but probably others (eg. Dutch) too.</p> <p>This issue seems caused by the fact that the i18n-strings used by the calendar view are a bit confusing. They contain task instead of issue in their names.</p> <p>I attach a patch which fixes the probable cause of the issue for all languages¹, as well as the actual translation issue in both the English (en) and Dutch (nl) translation-files.</p> <p>¹ by changing the following three i18n-strings which are used in <code>/app/views/calendars/show.html.erb</code> (only):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• from <code>:text_tip_task_begin_day</code> to <code>:text_tip_issue_begin_day</code>• from <code>:text_tip_task_end_day</code> to <code>:text_tip_issue_end_day</code>• from <code>:text_tip_task_begin_end_day</code> to <code>:text_tip_issue_begin_end_day</code>
